IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

1. The examination will be conducted online. You will be required to enter Login ID and Password to enter the On-Line exam site. Please ensure that you're Name and other details which will subsequently appear on the screen are correct.

2. Candidates should report at the center of the examination well in advance of the reporting time as indicated in the Admit Cards to complete activities such as verification of the candidate, capture of biometric (RTI and photo), collection of documents, announcement of instructions and logging in

3. The Candidate must bring his/her Admit Card at the respective Examination Centre. The candidate is also required to bring one of the Photo Identification in original viz. Voter ID / Driving License / PAN Card / Passport, Aadhar Card/e-Aadhar Card etc for verification. The identity of the candidate will be matched from the original proof. No candidate shall be permitted in the examination centre without carrying Admit Card and original ID Proof under any circumstances.

4. No candidate will be allowed inside the test center after gate closing time i.e. 08:30 AM for Shift-I, 12:00 PM for Shift-II & 03:30 PM for Shift-III for CAT 1, 4,7.

- 13. Frisking will be done at entry point and during the examination. In the examination, if a candidate is (or has been) found guilty of: (i) using unfair means during the examination or (ii) impersonating or procuring impersonation by any person or (iii) misbehaving in the examination hall or (iv) resorting to any irregular or improper means in connection with his/her candidature for selection or (v) obtaining support for his/her candidature by any unfair means, such a candidate may, in addition to rendering himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution, will also be liable: (a) to be disqualified from the examination for which he/she is a candidate and (b) to be debarred, either permanently or for a specified period, from any examination or recruitment conducted by HSSC.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES APPEARING IN THE STENOGRAPHY TEST

- 1. The candidates will listen Mock audio & Actual audio carefully.
- 2. The candidates will be provided blank note books and pens for taking dictations wherein they will write their Roll Number, Name, Date of Exam and signature.
- 3. It is the responsibility of the candidate to ensure that his/her thumb impressions on the attendance sheet (Left) is clear and complete. Smudged / Unclear thumb impression may lead to disqualification of such candidate.
- 4. Document verification shall be carried out before the skill test. Candidates appearing in the examination must ensure that all the fingers of both Hands should be clean and clear without any colour to enable successful verification with Biometric samples taken at the time of CBT Exam
- 5. After reading Instructions, accept the declaration and click on "I'm ready to begin".
- 6. Do not worry, in case of above technical failure, you would be allow for re login and complete assessment time will be provided for test evaluation.

3	Do not use special keys or any key at the time of the examination, which is not necessary for the typing of the words given in the spoken text. Do not typing any special characters / symbols and symbols / symbols except those mentioned in the spoken text.
4	Type the words / words mentioned in the spoken text without any errors. When typing a word, only use Backspace key to fix that word within line . You cannot go back to the previous typed line using arrow key.
5	Be patient during examinations and keep calm. You can contact the lab invigilator for any problem, such as: -
	Key-board error
	Machine automatic shutdown
	Power interruption
	Browser crash
	Artificially expiring session
6	If the above mentioned technical problem occurs while the candidates / candidates are typing, then the opportunity of log-in will be provided again.
