IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES FOR WRITTEN EXAMINATION (OMR BASED) OF VARIOUS POSTS OF DIRECTOR GENERAL OF POLICE (SCIENTIFIC STAFF GROUP-C FOR FORENSIC SCIENCE LABORATORY) DEPARTMENT, HARYANA AGAINST ADVT. NO.03/2022 OF VARIOUS CATEGORIES

In continuation of Advt. No.3/2022 dated 29.09.2022, Examination Notice/Selection Criteria dated 16.12.2022 and public notice notifying the Syllabus for various posts (Category No. 1 to 16) of Director General of Police (Scientific Staff Group-C For Forensic Science Laboratory) Department, Haryana, it is hereby, notified for the information of all concerned candidates who have applied for above mentioned categories of posts that Written examination for Category No. 3,4,9 and 16 will be held on 31.12.2022 and written examination for category 1,2,5,6,7,8,10,11,12,13,14and 15 will be held on 01.01.2023. In the written examination for the above-mentioned categories of posts there will be total 100 Multiple Choice Questions having 0.95 marks weightage for each question. In the written examination for all above categories of posts all questions are compulsory to be attempted. Each question will be having total Four (4) options out of which One (1) option for each question is required to be filled mandatorily. In case, a candidate does not mark any one of the four options for any question then 0.95 mark will be deducted for each unattempted question.

Further, in the notice dated Nil regarding notification of syllabus for the above mentioned posts, inadvertently an incomplete note was incorporated at the end and same may now please be read as:-

"Note-1: - The total no. of questions will be 100 with weightage of 0.95 marks for each question. All questions are compulsory, at least one of the four options for each question shall be filled mandatorily. 5 Minutes extra shall be given to mark at least one of the four options. Total time allowed for the paper will be (100+5)=105 minutes including these five minutes. In case a candidate doesn't

mark none of the four options for any question then 0.95 marks will be deducted for each un-attempted question."

Note-2 Further, the candidates are advised to be careful while attempting the written examination as unattempted questions/answer will lead to negative marking. The said instructions would also be available on the Question Booklet to be provided at the time of written examinations.

Note-3 Further, in view of condition No.24 of Admit Card, candidates are advised to read the instructions available on the Commission's website, Admit Card, Question Booklets, OMR/Answer Sheets etc. before attempting the written examination.

Note-4 Each question has four alternative answer of which only one is correct. For each question, darken only one circle on Original copy only of OMR Sheet which ever you think is the correct answer on the OMR answer sheet with only Blue/Black Ball Pen provided by the Commission. The candidates are warned not to mark anything on Commission's copy and Candidate's copy. The impression of Original OMR sheet will automatically be marked on Commission's copy and Candidate's copy of OMR answer sheet. Pencil should not be used for darkening the circle. If, more than one circle is found darkened, that particular answer will not be evaluated. Further, if a candidate attempt smudging/ scratching at any place in any manner on OMR Answer Sheet with Eraser, Nail, Blade, White Fluid/Whitener etc. then in such circumstances entire OMR Sheet/Answer Sheet will stand cancelled/rejected and same shall not be evaluated. The candidate himself/herself will be solely responsible for this.
