NOTICE TO THE CANDIDATES FOR PHYSICAL SCREENING TEST (PST) OF FEMALE CONSTABLE (G.D.) AGAINST ADVT. NO. 04/2020, CAT. NO. 02 OF POLICE DEPARTMENT, HARYANA

It is notified for information of all candidates who have qualified knowledge test/ written examination and have been shortlisted for PST that Haryana Staff Selection Commission will hold the **Physical Screening Test (PST)** for the post of **Female Constable (G.D.)** against **Advt. No. 04/2020, Cat. No. 02 of Police Department, Haryana** from dated **11.10.2021 to 13.10.2021** as per schedule given below:-

Physical Screening Test (PST):-

- Candidates, equalling seven (07) times the number of vacancies in each category shall be declared to have qualified the Knowledge Test (KT).
- The candidates who have qualified in Knowledge Test shall be put to a Physical Screening Test, which would be only qualifying in nature, to judge their physical fitness and endurance. The standards prescribed for this test shall be as under:-

Candidates	Test distance	Qualifying Time
1. Female	1.0 Kilometer	6 minutes

Note: RFID (Radio Frequency Identification Device) or any other superior and reliable technology shall be used to ensure reliability of this test at the discretion of the Haryana Staff Selection Commission.

- The responsibility of having the requisite medical fitness to undergo this test shall rest upon the candidate.
- The candidates who fail to meet the standards prescribed for Physical Screening Test shall stand eliminated from further selection process.
- The result of physical screening test shall be prepared by the Haryana staff selection commission. The Haryana staff selection commission shall display the same on its official website.
- Only the candidates who qualify the standards prescribed for Physical Screening Test shall be allowed to take part in the further process of selection.

Note:- The candidates belonging to dependants of Ex-Servicemen and dependants of Freedom Fighters category are required to complete in Physical Screening Test with standards similar to the candidates belonging to their respective categories i.e. "General, SC, BC-A, BC-B". Process of holding Physical Screening Test and instructions shall be notified separately before the PST.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATES FOR PHYSICAL SCREENING TEST (PST) ARE AVAILABLE ON WEBSITE OF THE COMMISSION i.e. www.hssc.gov.in WHICH SHOULD BE THOROUGHLY READ BY CANDIDATES BEFORE COMING FOR EXAMINATION.

Admit Card for PST of the candidates will be uploaded on the Commission web-site i.e. www.hssc.gov.in on dated **08.10.2021**. **Candidates are advised to read the instructions on the Admit Card carefully and follow the same strictly.**

No separate information will be sent to the candidates by the Commission through post.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES FOR PHYSICAL SCREENING TEST

1. **All Candidates who intend to appear in Physical Screening Test (PST) be advised to get themselves vaccinated against Covid/Corona immediately.**
2. Candidates must go through the instructions below as well as prescribed on the Admit Card carefully before coming for the Physical Screening Test.
3. Candidate must bring 2 original Copies of legibly printed Admit Card with recent colored photo pasted on Admit Card duly attested by Gazetted Officer and one identity proof with photo like Driving License, Voter Card, Aadhar Card, Passport etc. at the time of Physical Screening Test failing which candidate will not be allowed for PST.
4. Candidate should report the venue along with his admit card as originally downloaded from website at the date and time mentioned therein. Entry in the venue shall not be allowed before the time mentioned in admit card. After the completion of one shift the entry for next shift shall start. Candidates should bring original Admit Card (not to be photostated) for Physical Screening Test (PST).
5. At the venue, candidate shall be given token number and then he shall go into the waiting area from where he shall be called as per his token number for registration. After registration he will be called for PST.
6. Taking drugs and other restricted medicine are strictly prohibited during Physical Screening Test (PST).
7. All the candidates who have applied for the post of Male Constable (Commando) should ensure that they meet the physical standards for the post and fit for the conduct of physical test. The candidate will participate in the Physical Screening Test at his/her own risk/responsibility. The commission or the government shall not be responsible for any mishappening or injury caused to him during the test.
8. The candidate can participate in the Physical Screening Test with/without shoes as per his/her choice but if an injury is caused the Commission or government shall not be responsible for the same.
9. Procedure:-
 - i) Registration of candidate by capturing photographs & biometric finger print after confirming the identity from ID produced by candidate.
 - ii) Providing separate chest number & RFID tags.
 - iii) The candidates are required to pass through all the points of runway and if a candidate's chip is not recorded at any point, He/she shall be declared fail and for such failure he himself shall be responsible.
 - iv) De-registration, obtaining Bio-metric and taking back RFID chip & chest number at end of race/walking test.
10. PST will be done only of those candidates whose roll numbers are there in result published by commission.
11. Candidates are warned not to carry any mobile phone, any type of watch, belt, wear ornaments like ring, chain, earring etc., electronic or communication device at the PST venue. If any candidate is found possessing any such item, he will not be allowed to enter in the PST venue. Candidate found possessing mobile phone and any other aiding material/device as mentioned above at the PST venue will be treated serious violation and it will amount to cancellation of the candidature and debarring him from future examination of HSSC.
12. The PST will be supervised by doing frisking before allowing entry into PST venue, using CCTV Cameras, Scanning of QR Code/ Attendance, Facial Biometric Attendance and Videography etc. at the PST venue to stop impersonation etc.
13. **Biometric date captured at the time of written exam will be matched with the date captured before PST. In case of biometric mismatch of candidate, he will not be allowed to participate in the test.**
14. Candidate's request to change the Date or Session for PST shall not be entertained.
15. All candidate are bound to follow the instructions given by HSSC and if not followed, his candidature may be cancelled.
16. If any candidate is found creating any kind of indiscipline, his candidature may be cancelled.
17. Mobile phones or any kind of electronic instruments are strictly prohibited at the test site.
18. PST will be as per HSSC Advt. No. 04/2020 which is already available on Commission's website i.e. www.hssc.gov.in.
